



Garden Waste Collection Service 2020

If you haven't already done so, we would like to remind you to renew your subscription for the garden waste collection service which starts again from 2 March 2020 and runs until mid-December 2020.

You can sign up at any time during the year, but if you sign up early, you benefit from the full collection service for the season as well as the preferential subscription rate available before 29 February 2020. Subscriptions before this date or online throughout the season are £32 per bin. After 1 March 2020, the standard rate will be £35 if not paying online.

New customers can sign up to the service at any point by clicking on the link below or by calling us on 01352 701234.

This year, we will be moving to a tag system instead of a sticker for the brown bins. The tags are yellow and show the Flintshire "F" logo and a unique serial number. The tags will be sent directly to residents along with instructions of how to attach the tag to the brown bins. The tags must be fixed to the handle of the brown bin and be clearly visible to the collection crew, otherwise they may not be collected. The Council will not empty garden waste bins that do not have a valid tag attached.

All the garden waste that is collected is composted locally in the County and contributes to our national recycling targets. Last year, we collected over XXX tonnes and we collect from over 33,000 households.

Garden waste is composted at our facility in Greenfield, Holywell. You can put bark,

grass cuttings, cut flowers, weeds, leaves, hedge clippings, twigs and small branches in the garden waste bins. The bins cannot be used for fruit and vegetable peelings, food waste, cardboard, paper, soil and rubble or pet litter and animal waste.
